### The Basics

#### Big Steve's Grill

Open seven days a week for dine-in, take-out, delivery, and catering. Open on Monday from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday through Thursday from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m., Friday from 11 a.m. to 9 p.m., Saturday from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. and

Sunday from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

### The Buzz

Big Steve's Grill is family-owned and operated. They offer delivery within Plainville, Bristol, Farmington, and Southington. Any sandwich can be turned into a combo (medium drink and choice of one of the

following: french fries, mac and cheese, potato salad, or coleslaw) for an additional \$3.29.

### The Scene

Bright and colorful interior. The floors are hardwood and the walls are orange and yellow and filled with posters, photos, and puzzles.

### In Your Glass

Big Steve's Grill serves fountain and bottled soda as well as Foxon Park Soda. They have several flavors

of milkshakes including: chocolate, vanilla, strawberry, caramel, and peanut butter.

### On your plate

A large selection of grilled items such as: burgers, hotdogs, chili dogs, and grilled chicken sandwiches. The mac and cheese, soups (New England clam chowder, lobster bisque, chicken noodle, spicy corn chowder, and french onion), and chili are made fresh in the restaurant. Bread

bowls are available year round. Breakfast is served on Saturday and Sunday mornings.

### The Wallet

Burgers, sandwiches, and grinders start at \$2.69 for a kielbasa dog and go up to \$7.99 for pulled pork and cole slaw. Free Fixins (lettuce, tomato, mayonnaise, onions, pickles, hot or sweet relish, hot sauce, fried peppers, fried onions, fried mushrooms, tartar sauce, cocktail sauce, sweet and sour

sauce, ketchup, mustard, BBQ sauce, and honey mustard) can be added.

Fried seafood ranges from \$3.99 for a clam strip roll to \$14.99 for a Combo Plate (whole belly clams, fish, shrimp, fries, and coleslaw.)

Desserts start at \$1.19 for cookies and goes up to \$4.99 for fried cheesecake.
